Application for Plant Biology and Conservation Research Award

The Master's Program in Plant Biology and Conservation offers awards of up to \$1,500 for research related expenses. These may include costs such as lab materials, travel to distant field sites (reimbursement for commuting to a local field site will not be funded), or field equipment expenses.

Application materials:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Up to three pages for a research description (font no smaller than 11, single or double spaced)
- 3. Literature cited (not included in the 3 page limit above)
- 4. Budget and justification include the cost of requested items/travel and indicate why they are needed (not included in 3 page limit above)
- 5. One letter of reference
- 6. Your curriculum vitae

A well written research description should be clearly structured and include:

- 1. Brief background on the topic that sets the stage for your research project
- 2. Clearly stated objectives/hypotheses
- 3. Methods for addressing your objectives/hypotheses
- 4. Plans for analyses and interpretation of data (and preliminary results if available)
- 5. Significance of the project
